## DIRECTIONS TO TERWILLIGER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

### 301 NW 62<sup>nd</sup> St. Gainesville

FROM I -75: take the Newberry Road Exit in Gainesville. Go east (to Gainesville) on Newberry Rd past the Oaks Mall on your right and NFRMC Hospital on left. NW 62<sup>nd</sup> Blvd is the street after the Oaks Mall. Burger King is on the opposite corner. Turn right (south) on 62<sup>nd</sup> Blvd. School is on the left.

FROM DOWNTOWN GAINESVILLE OR UF AREA: go west on Newberry Rd. towards Oaks Mall. 62<sup>nd</sup> Street is after McDonald's on your left. Turn left (south) at the street between Burger King and the Oaks Mall. Terwilliger is on the left side. Look for Camp signs.
